

CONDITIONS OF TRADE / SALE

MAFKILDEA CONDITIONS OF TRADE SOLID FLOORING GENERAL

1 These Conditions of Trade shall apply to all goods supplied ("The Goods") by MAFKILDEA ("The Company,") to any person firm, or company ("the Customer") and shall override any condition of purchase placed upon any orders by any customer.

2. All goods supplied by the Company shall be deemed to be made under a contract incorporating these Conditions of Trade and shall be interpreted in accordance with English Law irrespective of the residence domicile or principal trading address of the Customer wherever the address to which the Goods are supplied.

3. If any one or more of the provisions of these Conditions of Trade shall be adjudged by any Court to be unfair within the meaning of the Unfair Contract Terms legislation or any statutory modification thereof then only those particular provisions shall be unenforceable but the remaining provisions of these Conditions of Trade shall continue in full force and effect

4. These Conditions of Trade embody the whole of the Agreement between the Company and the Customer and the Customer acknowledges that the Customer has not entered into this Contract with the Company as a result of any representation or warranty oral or written made by or on behalf of the Company.

SPECIFIC

1. At the Company's discretion in respect of any order the Company may request the Customer to pay all or part of the price thereof prior to the Company supplying Goods. If the Customer shall not make such prepayment as requested the Company shall be under no liability to supply any goods to the Customer

2. The prices quoted for the Goods to the Customer are subject to any increase by the Company becoming effective between the date of order and the date of delivery (which shall be the invoice date) and any goods supplied shall be invoiced at the price current therefore at the date of delivery. In the event that the Customer requires goods to be supplied in a shorter period of time than that originally agreed the Company may at its discretion employ persons outside normal working hours to meet the Customers requirements but any additional charges incurred thereby shall be paid by the Customer in addition to the quoted price.

3. Unless otherwise stated all prices quoted shall be exclusive of Value Added Tax at the appropriate rate and carriage charges which may be added to the invoice by the Company and shall be payable as part of the invoice.

4. All invoices are payable on the date of issue thereof. The Company may at its absolute discretion on any one or more contracts grant to the Customer 30 days credit in which to pay for the Goods supplied but this shall not affect the fact that all invoices are payable on the date of issue

5. Any sums due under any invoice shall bear interest at the rate of 5% over Bank of England Base Rate from the date they are due for payment until the date of actual payment such interest to be calculated on a daily basis.

6. In the event of the Company deciding to employ solicitors or other agencies all or any sums due from any Customer to the Company the costs so incurred by the Company shall be paid by the Customer such costs not being limited to those recoverable under a Court action.

7. Property in any goods supplied by the Company to a Customer does not pass to the Customer until the Goods have been paid for in full. Risk in the Goods however shall pass on delivery to the Customer who shall insure such Goods to their full value Until such time as payment for the Goods in full has been received by the Company the Customer shall hold such Goods or any moneys representing the sale proceeds thereof as trustee for the Company. In the event of any goods not being paid for in full by the date upon which payment thereof was due the Company shall have power to recover possession of those goods or any other goods supplied by the Company to the Customer and retained by the Customer and the Customer hereby expressly grants licence to the Company to enter upon any premises upon which such goods are located to recover possession thereof.

8. The Company shall be at liberty in the event of it being unable to obtain from its supplier supplies of any particular item ordered by the Customer to cancel any order placed by the Customer or at the Customers option to supply an equivalent item of equal quality and value and shall not be deemed to be in breach of contract by so doing.

9. The Company will not be responsible for any loss or damage of whatsoever nature and howsoever caused to the Customer or to any third party or their respective business or employees as a result of any defect in the Goods supplied or the packaging thereof or any use to which they are put by the Customer or any third party.

10. Any claim for damage to or short delivery of or generally concerning goods supplied (unless it is a claim covered by special condition 6 hereof - moisture content) shall be notified by the Customer to the Company in writing within 72 hours of the date of delivery in default of which no claim shall arise against the Company in respect of such damage or short delivery.

11 Any claim made by the Court against the Company in respect of losses arising as a result of any defect in the Goods supplied or any short delivery shall be limited to the value of the Goods supplied.

12. The company will use as best endeavours to supply goods upon the dates specifically agreed in writing between the Company and the Customer but in the event of the Company being unable to meet such dates no claim shall arise against the Company by the Customer.

13. The Company may at its absolute discretion refuse to supply any goods to any Customer and in such event shall notify such customer in writing of its decision not to supply as aforesaid.

14. Unless otherwise agreed in writing no goods supplied by the Company to the Customer are on sale or return or sample basis: no goods once delivered may be returned to the Company without prior authority from the Company unless those goods are accepted by the Company as being defective in some way. In the event of a return being authorised by the Company the Company shall have the right to charge carriage to and from the delivery location and a handling charge of up to 35% of the value of the goods. In the event of the goods being returned in a damaged or un-saleable condition, the Company shall have the right to charge the Customer at the full resale value of these goods.

15. The Company shall not be liable for any breach of Contract for the supply of goods if it is prevented from performing its part of the Contract by any matter whatsoever beyond its control. In addition the Company shall not be responsible in any way for the acts or omissions of any third party employed by the Customer direct or for any liability howsoever arising incurred by the Customer in or by reason of the Customers employment of such third party.

16. There will be no discount on invoices unless specifically agreed between the Company and the Customer and further in the event of any invoice upon which discount been agreed not being paid by its due date then discount will be forfeit.

17. Preparatory to entering into any Contract the Company may supply to the Customers drawings technical specifications catalogues and other matter based upon information supplied by the Customer to assist the Customer in planning his requirements. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure the accuracy of the same the Company takes no responsibility for any items so supplied and it is the Customers responsibility to ensure that all the information given by him and items supplied to him are accurate and to the Customers satisfaction.

18. No order once placed may be cancelled by the Customer who will accept delivery of the Goods when the Company shall so require. If the Customer shall continue to refuse delivery for 30 days after the Company shall require the same the Company shall be at liberty to raise an invoice to the value of the Goods so ready to be supplied and the Customer will pay the Company the invoice price. In addition the Company shall be at liberty to charge storage for any goods undelivered at the rate of £25 per day from the date the Company notifies the Customer that it is able to deliver the Goods and the date when the Customer accepts such delivery. such storage charges to be paid in cash on delivery.

19. No order when once placed with the Company can be varied without the Company's consent. In the event of the Company agreeing to vary any order the costs of all additional works done by the Company both in design or production shall be paid by the Customer either at the date of such variation or at the date of delivery of the Goods whichever the Company shall decide.

SPECIAL 1. The Customer shall ensure that the Goods once delivered to the Customer shall be stored in appropriate conditions to preserve the moisture content at the time of delivery and the Company shall not be responsible for any change in the moisture content of the Goods due to storage in unsuitable conditions.

2. The Company will endeavour to supply the Goods with the correct moisture content but the amount of such moisture content may vary and the Company shall be under no liability for such variation.

3. The Company will endeavour to supply the Goods to the specified size and colour but shall not be responsible for minor variations in size colour, texture, general wood quality and. Timber being a natural product, variations in colour, texture, grain and machining tolerance are to be expected.

4. In the case of Goods which are imported then the same shall be subject to the grading rules of those goods in the country of manufacture.

5. The Customer shall ensure that he provides adequate labour to unload the Goods on arrival.

6. The Customer ensure that the moisture content of the Goods is checked immediately upon delivery with an accurately calibrated moisture meter and any complaint concerning the moisture content must be made by telephone and confirmed in writing 24 hours of the date of delivery. In the event of a complaint being made the Goods should be thoroughly re-wrapped and stored in appropriate conditions to preserve the moisture content at the date of delivery. Failure to comply with this condition shall absolve the Company from all further liability on the claim.

NOTES

Wood is a natural product and no two pieces will be exactly alike always check you have ordered the correct grade. Do not store or install the product unless surroundings and subfloors are completely dry (new concrete will require approximately one inch a month to dry) . Flooring should be installed within the installation area at normal expected living conditions for around a week to acclimatise , depending on the particular product. Do not open cartons of engineered flooring until immediately prior to installation .We recommend that very high traffic areas such as kitchens are given a further coat of lacquer or oil. Full grading specifications on all products are available from the office. A dimension tolerance of 2% is allowed by manufacturers and a grading allowance of 5% of product above and below grade. Always refer to manufacturers and our information guides regarding fitting and care and maintenance. Information Guides and our Terms and conditions are available from our web site or copies can be obtained from the address above. Solid hardwood floors should not normally be installed below ground level. Wood is a natural dynamic material and tolerances may vary according to percentage of moisture content and other variables.

mafkildea General Grading All wood flooring is generally supplied tongue and groove all round in random lengths . All flooring is kiln dried and supplied at under 10 % moisture content from our humidity controlled warehouse. Pre lacquered or oiled wood floors will be supplied in cardboard cartons and unfinished in bundles. We purchase from over 50 manufacturers world-wide, all with different grading rules , all hardwood is inspected and graded to our specifications. Always consult us if you require a full grading specification on your particular choice of wooden flooring. There is a number of sub gradings within the three main gradings such as select and better which would indicate a slightly higher grading than the normal select grade.

Select grade These are some of the highest grades available and are the most expensive. The timbers selected will be on the whole more even in patina and colour and contain limited knotting . Straightest grain and the least number of burrs and character marks.

Classic grade A middle grading with colour variation between heartwood and sapwood , some knotting and the trees natural mineral streaks, wild grain, surface checks, burrs and other character figuring.

Traditional grade More colour flashes , larger knotting , character marks and burrs, some filling and wilder grain, with natural mineral streaks and trace elements from the trees original location. A very serviceable floor with plenty of character and interest.
